INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON PLASTICITY, DAMAGE & FRACTURE 2026 (ICPDF 2026), will take place from January 3 to January 8, 2026 in Geelong, Australia at Novotel Geelong (Jan. 3-4) and Deakin Waterfront Campus (Jan. 5-7), with cultural excursion taking place on Jan.8. Novotel and Waterfront Campus are within close proximity to each other. This Conference series is the prime forum for plasticity, damage and fracture research dissemination as usually 300-400 scientists from around the world participate in this conference, including many IJP editorial board members, authors and reviewers, as well as several editors of other journals.

Technical Areas

The conference will focus on multi-scale computational Plasticity, emerging materials (nano-crystalline solids, high entropy alloys, thin films, bio-materials, polymers etc.) and micro mechanics of plastic deformation and texture evolution, including materials science aspects, metal forming, and elastic-plastic damage and fracture mechanics. However, presentations in any area of plasticity, damage & fracture will be welcomed, especially experimental and materials science studies related to plastic deformation, damage and fracture. Also, the topics of interest include plastic and visco-plastic behaviors of single crystals and poly-crystalline metals, nanocrystalline metals, thin films, bio-materials, ceramics, ice, rocks and soils, composite materials and polymers, as well as plasticity aspects of damage, failure and fracture mechanics.

Presentations

The presentations will include distinguished keynote (45 mins.) & keynote invited lectures (30 mins) and invited presentations of 15 mins. in each of three parallel sessions. The invited keynote lecture is expected to partly give an overview of the subject area. All presentations, including invited lectures, must contain a significant amount of unpublished results. A live hybrid conference option is also available for a few hours per day due to the time difference between the continents. Kindly follow the deadlines given at the top.

Travel Information to Geelong

Melbourne (Tullamarine) Airport is an international airport located approximately 90 km northeast (or a 1 hour drive) from the conference venue

Shuttle Bus Services Gull bus

The <u>Gull Airport Service</u> operates regular shuttle bus services directly between Melbourne Airport and Geelong Railway Station, with a one-way adult fare of \$35 AUD (approximately \$23 USD or €20 EUR). Geelong Railway Station is 800 metres (5 minute drive or 11 minute flat walk) to Novotel Geelong.

SkyBus

SkyBus operates regular services between both Melbourne Airport and Melbourne Southern Cross Railway Station, with a one-way adult fare between \$25 AUD (approximately \$16 USD or €14 EUR)

Public Transport - Train

<u>Vline</u> train services are regularly available from Melbourne's Southern Cross Station (see <u>timetables</u>), expect a travel time of approximately 1 hour. Peak one-way fees is approximately \$10 AUD (approximately \$6.50 USD or €5.60 EUR.

Note: A <u>Myki card</u> is required for Vline travel and may be purchased from any train station. There are no direct train services available from either Melbourne and Avalon Airports to Geelong.

ETA (Electronic Travel Authorisation) VISA Information

The following countries require to have Electric Visa Authorization (ETA), i.e., (Andorra, Austria, Belgium, Brunei, Canada, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hong Kong (SAR of China), Iceland, Italy, Japan, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Malaysia, Malta, Monaco, Norway, Portugal, Republic of San Marino, Singapore, South Korea, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Taiwan (excluding official or diplomatic passports), The Netherlands, United Kingdom—British Citizen, United Kingdom—British National (Overseas), United States of America, Vatican City). No invitation letter is required for ETA.
